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UPDATED PROGRAM PROPOSAL (October 2015)

TCGR's membership-driven approach will shorten the timeline to commercial introduction of new materials science and process technologies **using a pro-active screening methodology** to focus results via built-in relationships between the R&D, development/scale-up and commercialization roles among industrial participants. Members will interact, on an exclusive basis, with potential customers and development partners yielding measurable gains in speed-to-market.



Success in new material, process and product commercialization comes from streamlining the progression of ideas to market by focusing resources and leveraging investments (i.e., screening and prioritizing the R&D funnel). **TCGR's methodology will focus on screening out non-viable or less probable projects, heightening efficiencies in project evaluation and selection.**

- Through TCGR's **ACMS Program**, consortium members will be introduced to like-minded organizations seeking new markets/applications for their company's materials or processes, working together to speed up the "Innovation to Growth" cycle.
- TCGR will provide the means by which interactions occur, serving as a pro-active concierge to coordinate information and engage needed resources, yielding shortened development times and improved likelihood of success.
- The membership will consist of divisions from within larger companies (or small- to medium-size companies) that are entrepreneurial in nature and can benefit most from improved networks up and down the value chain.

Critical to the success of the **ACMS Program** will be the development of intellectual property (IP) by and/or between member companies. As part of the program's routine operations, the information shared will be focused on subject opportunities and be based on publicly available/non-proprietary sources, sufficient for members to conduct initial assessments of interest. Beyond this (i.e., outside of the program's operations) individual companies will be encouraged to sign non-disclosure agreements (NDAs) or reach other terms in order to pursue JIPs.



Key Benefits

With their interaction, the members will screen new materials and technologies from potential customers; in turn, end-users with materials or process needs highlight how members can work together towards technological and/or commercial development.

- ✓ TCGR will bring a diversity of partners together to help expedite R&D and commercialization projects from the bench through business development, including via Joint Innovation Projects (JIPs)

Deliverables

The specific scope/content of each deliverable will be determined by the membership, with regularly scheduled calls and interactive balloting. Included among these are:

- Monthly (12) "ACMS Alert" newsletters (via email) addressing the latest announcements from the commercial side that involve related material science and process technologies, including commentary and additional insights specifically targeted towards member company interests and needs
- On demand/as needed webinars (i.e., 3-4 per year) that expand upon the "ACMS Alerts" by providing the following, both regionally and globally, based on members' input:
 - Assessment of new growth markets
 - Current companies across the value chain and potential new entrants
 - Growth/impacts of new technologies (and/or hurdles impeding their success)
 - o Progress of potential game changing programs and other opportunity identification
- Each webinar will be interactive, with the members encouraged (via round table discussion) to share thoughts and best practices on the developments and impacts in their industry (to include subject experts from TCGR's exclusive Dialog Group®)



Deliverables (cont'd)

- Member-provided proposals for partnership/JIP opportunities, to be shared immediately with members (via email "ACMS Action" emails) to heighten visibility and emphasize timelines
- Regularly scheduled calls with individual member companies in order to tailor interactions so that value of participation is maximized
- Members' **Annual Meeting** with ability to network, share current opportunities along the value chain and hear from experts contributing to the program deliverables (emails, webinars, etc.)







Pricing

Membership will be conducted on an annual basis with fees in the \$16.5K - \$19.5K per year range, to be determined based on number of "charter" subscribers and final scope. Renewal will occur annually thereafter.



Takeaway

The commercialization of ideas requires pro-active product/process screening to focus on a limited number of more viable projects, assessing scale-up, testing and, in some cases, partnership with the target/prospective market. The leveraging and acceleration of skills and resources through TCGR's ACMS Program is aimed at achieving this goal. By bringing together the leading commercial and scientific minds, from both the technology and business development sides in industrial technology, this program will speed technology commercialization in materials and processes, thereby generating business growth.
